The National Park Service is preparing a Port-Orford Cedar Management Plan to guide the management of Port-Orford Cedar in Redwood National and State Parks. Port-Orford Cedar in the parks is found primarily in Del Norte County in the Smith River watershed. Most management actions would occur in that area.
