The maintenance facility project was analyzed in an earlier environmental assessment that was issued in December 2004 and approved by the National Park Service in December 2005.


To provide water for the new facility, the National Park Service and the California Department of Parks and Recreation propose to drill an on-site well with waterlines and a storage tank.
